## COMMISSIONS AND PREMIERS

### ***In Dreams – Cait Nishimura***

*In Dreams* was commissioned by a consortium led by the University of Portland Wind Symphony and conductor Patrick Murphy. The piece explores the dichotomy/duality and crossover between reality and dreams. We were thrilled that 38 bands (including school, community, and university ensembles) from eleven states and four provinces were a part of the consortium. The piece will be available to the public in November 2019.

Cait Nishimura is a Canadian composer and music educator based in Toronto, Ontario. Described as having a "refreshing buoyancy," her music uses minimalist patterns, simple yet lush harmonies, and themes that linger in listeners' minds, drawing inspiration from the beauty of the natural world. Nishimura strives to present contemporary concert music that is accessible and approachable by musicians of all levels. Her work for wind band, *Chasing Sunlight* was selected as the winner of the 2017 Canadian Band Association Composition Competition, and has since been added to the Music Fest Canada syllabus. Nishimura holds undergraduate degrees in music and education from the University of Toronto. Her work is regularly programmed and commissioned by ensembles across North America, where she is in demand as a visiting composer and educator. The International Society for Research and Promotion of Wind Music (IGEB) is pleased to invite submissions of proposals, posters, or lecture-performances for the 24th International Conference on Wind Music, to be held in Valencia (Spain) July 23-27, 2020, at "Joaquín Rodrigo" Conservatoire of Valencia and, for the last day, the Societat Musical Santa Cecilia d'Alcàsser.

#### Main theme: Wind Music: Providing Education & Building Society, Culture and Identity

The relevance of the military and civilian bands in education and their role in building the society, the music culture and the identity, is the main theme of this 24th International Conference. The lecturers are

especially invited to submit their proposals within the framework of the following categories:

- Wind music artistic societies, education and identity.
- Wind music repertoire, audiences and identity.
- Wind music teachers, composers and performers.
- Wind music, cultural environment and identity.
- Wind music and social development.
- Wind music and urban soundscapes.

In addition, we also welcome proposals exploring other approaches to wind music, including research in progress.

### **Michigan State University Bands Celebrate 150 Years**

The Michigan State University Bands celebrate a milestone year through 2019-2020. Started in 1870, the band has a legacy and tradition of excellence. Our celebration begins with the release of the latest MSU Wind Symphony recording, *King Mangoberry: Music of Ricardo Lorenz*.

Highlights of the 2019-2020 school year will be a significant Alumni Band presence and halftime recognition at the September 28, 2019 football game versus IU. The Spartan Marching Band (SMB) will showcase the innovations and evolutions of the SMB on the field.

The MSU Concert Band, Symphony Band, and Wind Symphony will premiere commissioned works by Aaron Perrine, Ivette Herryman, and Zhou Tian, respectively, to celebrate the 150<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the program. The University concert bands and Alumni Band will present a gala weekend to conclude the school year and the year-long celebration.

The MSU Wind Symphony travels to Italy for a performance tour celebrating the legacy of the MSU Bands and to honor Leonard Falcone, longtime Director of Bands from 1927-1967, a native of Italy.

### *King Mangoberry: Music of Ricardo Lorenz*

The Michigan State University Wind Symphony, under the direction of Kevin Sedatole, is excited to announce their newest recording featuring the music of MSU faculty composer Ricardo Lorenz.

This recording features new recordings of Lorenz's *King Mangoberry: Five Allegories for Wind Symphony*, which take a colorful and introspective look at diversity, and his innovative *Pataruco: Concerto for Venezuelan Maracas*, which features the virtuosic performance of maraca soloist Manuel Alejandro Rangel in a brilliant transcription by recent DMA wind conducting student, Travis Higa. The recording concludes with a live performance of *El Muro (The Wall)* from the MSU Wind Symphony's concert at the 2009 CBDNA National Conference held at The University of Texas at Austin.

As Cormac Cannon, of the University of South Carolina, writes in his foreword: "to experience the music of Ricardo Lorenz is to enter an inimitable sound world governed by confounding rhythm, inhabited by rich color, with a brilliant and at times foreboding formal landscape." We hope you check out this latest MSU Wind Symphony recording and enjoy the music of Ricardo Lorenz.
